Keynote Title: “From results to readership: publishing your research”

Bio: Roger Watson is a graduate of The University of Edinburgh with a PhD in biochemistry from The University of Sheffield who qualified in nursing at St George’s Hospital, London. Working in care of older people, he has a special interest in the feeding and nutritional problems of older people with dementia. He is Editor-in-Chief of *Journal of Advanced Nursing* and a frequent visitor to China and Australia where he has visiting positions. He was most recently Professor of Nursing, University of Sheffield and is a member of the Research Excellence Framework sub-panel in Allied Health Professions, Dentistry, Nursing and Pharmacy.

Abstract: From the Editor-in-Chief of *Journal of Advanced Nursing* (who is also the Editor of *Nursing Open*) this session will provide an overview of publishing nursing research: problems; standards and trends. In recent years, there has been a rise in the production of publication standards, particularly in medicine, and these apply to nursing and include: CONSORT; PRISMA; COPE, and ICJME standards, which will be covered. Giving manuscripts international appeal and advice how to make a manuscript as applicable and interesting to as wide an audience as possible will be covered. Peer review and its different forms and how to deal effectively with reviewers will be included using the ‘Three Golden Rules’. The rise of social media – particularly Twitter® – and its use by the academic community generally and by nurses to promote their research and publications will be included. The dangerous rise of predatory open access publishers will be mentioned and how to avoid them and guidance on legitimate open access publishing will be provided.
