Title: "Shift Happens-Be more Resilient to Thrive through Change. Teaching and learning during Covid"

Abstract: For educators, lecturers, teachers and learners the COVID-19 Pandemic is a quintessential adaptive and transformative difficult step, one for which there is not any guidance that can lead them to able to know what to do, how to take a step

and for suitable answers responses. Education leaders, teachers, lecturers must quickly give answers and feedback to learners – and with pre-prepared contexts and responses in mind. As the pandemic is still and unfortunately going on, in other words, runs its course, we all have to know and take a further step to run our courses since education never stops, should never stop.
